

World ParaVolley Sport Regulations: Sitting Volleyball Team Uniforms

UNIFORM JERSEY (SHIRT)

- a. FRONT NUMBER 15 cm high and no less than 2 cm wide stripe (centred).
- b. No numbers on the sleeves.
- c. **LOGO**: Approved manufacturer's logo: Logo should fit within **30 cm²**, usually a rectangle **6 cm long** and **5 cm high**. It should preferably be on the front right-hand side.
- d. Country flag and country name:
 Combined minimum 36 cm² and maximum 40 cm² on the front upper left side.
 The country name or the official IOC/IPC country code (3 letters) must be below the flag.
- e. Back number 20 cm high and no less than 2 cm wide stripe (centred below the player's registered jersey name).
- f. Letters for the player's registered **jersey name** (i.e. family name or usual preferred name or "nickname") on the back of playing uniforms above the number, **4 or 6 cm high** and no less than **0.5 cm wide** stripe.

WOMEN	Under 10 letters	6 cm high and no less than 1 cm wide stripe.
	10 letters and over	4 cm high and no less than 0.5 cm wide stripe.
MEN	Under 12 letters	6 cm high and no less than 1 cm wide stripe.
	12 letters and over	4 cm high and no less than 0.5 cm wide stripe.

g. Captain's Stripe: height 2 cm and width 8 cm. The Captain's stripe must be centred under the number on the front of the jersey.

4 cm high, no less than 0.5 cm wide stripe.


MEN Under 12 letters


LOGO

Homologated manufacturer's logo:
Logo should fit within **30 cm²**,
usually a rectangle



6 cm long and 5 cm high.

It should preferably be on the front right-hand side.

FLAG

Country flag/NPC emblem

TOGETHER with


the country/territory name or IOC/IPC Code is placed on the front upper left side with a



COMBINED size between min. **36** cm² and max. **40** cm²

Only the country name or the official IOC/IPC country code (3 letters) is to be used and must be below the flag.





While 5cm X 8cm is the most common size, it should be noted that the area must be a minimum of 36cm² and a maximum of 40cm².

A ruler should be used to measure the dimensions to ensure conformity.



The dimension of the captain's stripe

height 2 cm, width 8 cm.



The captain's stripe must be located **centred under the number on the front** of the jersey.

ADVERTISING RECOMMENDATIONS

To enable teams to recognise their sponsors, and thus raise financial support, the World ParaVolley Sport Department is now permitting teams to use advertising on jerseys, without a need for World ParaVolley licensing or payment of a fee.

It should be noted that advertising is not allowed in the Paralympic Games or other IPC-owned Regional Games such as the Parapan American Games.


World ParaVolley recommends that the size of the advertising should not exceed:

- 300 cm2 in one block on the front of the jersey, and;
- 50 cm2 on each jersey sleeve.

However, teams are permitted to use two blocks of advertising on the front of the jersey:

- 1. One 300cm2 block above the number for one main team sponsor. Block is to be no more than 11cm high, and must contain only one line of text or one image.
- 2. One 300cm2 block below the number. This can be used for one or multiple advertisers.

Use of the World ParaVolley logo is strongly recommended on a sleeve(s).






The size of the advertising must not exceed 33 cm² in one block on the front or the back of the warming up suit and must be identical to the advertising on the jersey.
