

## World ParaVolley Team Testing Pool

World ParaVolley maintains a Team Testing Pool (TP) as part of its anti-doping programme. Teams included in the Team Testing Pool may be selected for Out-of-Competition (OoC) Testing.

### Inclusion

World ParaVolley has the discretion to select teams for inclusion in the Team Testing Pool based on criteria relevant to its anti-doping programme, including rankings, competition participation and other factors identified through its testing and risk-assessment processes.

### Teams Currently Included in the Team Testing Pool (from September 2026):

### Obligations of Athletes in the Team Testing Pool

Athletes belonging to teams included in the Team Testing Pool are required to comply with the applicable whereabouts requirements established by the World ParaVolley Anti-Doping Rules. Where required, athletes must provide sufficient and accurate information to enable World ParaVolley or another Anti-Doping Organization with authority to test them to locate them for testing. This may include information regarding overnight accommodation, training activities and locations, competition participation, and other information necessary to facilitate Out-of-Competition (OoC) testing.

Whereabouts information must be provided through **ADAMS**, where applicable. Athletes are responsible for ensuring that the information they provide is accurate and kept up to date.

### Testing

Teams in the TP may be subject to Out-of-Competition Testing at any time in accordance with the WPV Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA Code. Testing may be conducted by World ParaVolley or by another Anti-Doping Organization with the authority to test athletes. Inclusion in the Testing Pool does not exempt athletes from any other testing conducted under the World Anti-Doping Code.

### Notification

World ParaVolley has notified the relevant athletes and/or teams of their inclusion in the Team Testing Pool and of any applicable obligations.
